Chapman receives award from IDFG

Joe Chapman, a 1975 graduate of Archbishop Bergan Catholic School, received the "Excellence in Aquaculture" Award, presented by the Idaho Chapter of the American Fisheries Society annual meeting in Pocatello, Idaho.

Each year the aquaculture branch of Idaho AFS selects one individual to receive the award. This is considered a "lifetime achievement" award in the aquaculture field. Chapman is the third person to have received this award.

"It was quite an honor to receive it, and quite unexpected and humbling, actually," Chapman said.

The Idaho Department of Fish and Game also has a separate Hatchery Manger of the Year award, for IDFG employees only, which Joe won back in 1998.

Chapman's twin brother, Jerry, also a 1975 Bergan graduate, received the "Hatchery Manager of the Year" award for IDFG in 2005.

Joe and Jerry are the sons of Robert and Theresa Chapman of Fremont.

Third grade -(Fall): above, 15; on grade level, 7; below, 1; (*Spring*): above, 18; on grade level, 5; below, 0.

4th grade -(*Fall*): above, 21; on grade level, 1; below, 4; Spring: above, 21; on grade level, 2; below, 3.
