

8.26.21: Indoor Co-Curricular COVID Guidelines

Lincoln Christian School is operating under compliance with the most recent directed health mandate for Lancaster County. As a result, the following protocols have been implemented for Saturday's Centennial Conference Volleyball Championship.

In light of the current directed health measure, we ask that spectators remain outside of the building as much as possible between games. Please feel free to stay on the Lincoln Christian School campus while staying off of the football and baseball fields.

Pre Screening

- Parents will screen their children at home for fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, etc.
- If symptomatic, students will not report to school/practice/contest, and parents will consult a medical professional.

Guidelines for Attending Indoor Competitions at Lincoln Christian School

- There are no capacity limitations on indoor sporting events.
- Everyone two years of age and older must wear a face covering while walking about the interior of the school building.
- While seated in the bleachers, fans must wear a face covering or meet one of the following exemptions.
 - Is under (2) years of age
 - Is able to maintain at least six feet of separation from any other individual at all times
 - Is seated to eat or drink, or while immediately consuming food beverages
 - Cannot otherwise wear a face covering because of a medical condition, a mental health condition, or a disability that prevents the wearing of a face covering
- Everyone in the student section must wear a face covering.
- No food or drink in the student section.

Expectations for Participants and Support Team at Home Games

- Players and officials *will* be expected to wear face coverings whenever they are not engaged in sport-specific physical activity or meeting one of the exemptions.
- Players and officials *will not* be expected to wear face coverings during the actual competition.

- Players and officials *will be* expected to wear face coverings when not engaged in competition. i.e. When on the sidelines, on the bench, in the hallways, etc.
- Coaches will follow the same guidelines for wearing a face covering as spectators.

Thank you for your patience and understanding during these unique times. We are grateful that our students continue to have the opportunity to compete and perform and will continue to do everything we can to provide co-curricular activities.
