you to all of the people that have had a hand in this annual fundraising night. The small army of volunteers along with the individuals and businesses that underwrite and donate to the Knight Event truly make a direct impact on the education that we offer. This event provides much needed revenue that directly impacts the budget and bottom line at Archbishop Bergan Catholic School each and every year. It costs roughly \$6,400 to educate a student in our school

system, while the Kindergarten through Twelfth grade student tuition rate averages \$3,500 a year. That leaves a \$2,900 gap in expenses that needs to be accounted for each and every year, for each and every student. Given that we have a little less than four hundred students in our school system this means we have over one million dollars that we must raise yearly.

# Welcome Father Benjamin Boyd



Father Boyd grew up in North Platte, Nebraska and graduated from St. Patrick's Catholic School. Fr. Ben's parents and oldest brother Jeff and

family live in Omaha, his brother Kevin and family live in Westborough, Massachusetts and his sister Jodi and family live in Beatrice. Fr. Ben attended the University of Nebraska at Lincoln for 2 years and then worked in construction and carpentry for the following 4 years. He entered Seminary at Conception Seminary College located in Conception, Missouri and later Kenrick-Glennon Seminary located in Shrewsbury, St. Louis. Fr. Ben was State Champion in wrestling while in high school and did some intermural wrestling while at UNL. He coached wrestling at Beatrice High School and has plans to assist coaching at Bergan.

When asked when he felt that call to become a priest, he replied that he 'never wanted to be a priest.' He wanted marriage and a family, not the life of a priest. After attending UNL,

he kept getting signs from God pointing him to the priesthood. He chose to ignore them, in vain, until he felt no pleasure or fulfillment and things kept going wrong in his life. After a five year span, Fr. Ben accepted his call to serve God in the priesthood and entered the Seminary. It was only after that surrender he felt an overwhelming peace.

We are very blessed to have Fr. Ben at St. Patrick's Parish and Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.

# Among our Graduates

Rick Gerrard ('75) is deputy director of the City of Phoenix Office of International Relations and vice president of Phoenix Sister Cities, Inc. He has served in this capacity since March 1999. Rick is responsible for handling matters of protocol and the programming of meetings and activities for the international delegations visiting the City of Phoenix on official business. In he is responsible for designing, organizing and coordinating international exchange-rated activities and events associated with ten sister cities around the world.

Prior to his arrival in Phoenix, Rick was deputy director of the Town Affiliation Association of the United States, Inc., better known as Sister Cities International, based in Washington, D.C. He spent ten years with Sister Cities International in various capacities where he managed grant programs and designed and conducted international exchange, training and development programs worldwide.

He has organized and conducted political, educational and trade delegations to more than two dozen industrialized and developing countries, including the first visit of United States mayors to South Africa after the collapse of apartheid in 1995; the first

visit of US mayors to Vietnam after the normalization of diplomatic ties in 1996; and the first visit of US mayors to Northern Ireland in 1997, just prior to the Good Friday Peace Accords in 1998.

Rick has been involved in international affairs for over twenty-six years. He received his master's degree in Latin American history from George Mason University in Fairfax, Virginia, and a bachelor's degree in social sciences and education from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. He speaks Spanish and Portuguese and served for over two years as a Peace Corps volunteer in Paraguay.

Connie Charleston Chudomelka (\*63) and her husband Kurt currently own Uncle Sam's Antiques located in downtown Fremont. Connie's siblings who graduated from St. Patrick's High School/Archbishop Bergan are brothers Keith Charleston (\*58) and Bob Charleston (\*72) and sister Karen Charleston Bergmanis(\*60). Connie's



For nearly 50 years, Joe Cajka, Jerry Mahlberg and Bob Vance supported Bergan in numerous capacities. Transporting teams and equipment, keeping stats, running the clock, starting track races, scouting other teams and assistance coaching are just a few of the countless tasks that they readily performed to keep Knight athletics moving in the right direction. Most noted for their long-time role as football stat keepers, Cajka, Mahlberg and Vance were fixtures on the Bergan Knight sidelines for over four decades. These three men were outstanding examples of Christian lives lived for the benefit of others. They served on the School Board, Booster Club Board and donated coutless hours of their time, talent and treasure to St. Patrick's Parish as well. Their spirit of selflessness is at the core of what it means to be a St. Patrick's-Archbishop Bergan Knight and their legacy endures with every hour of volunteer service that continues to this day.



# Clinton "Buddy" Lord Athlete 1948-1951

Buddy was a member of the original graduating class of St. Patrick's High School in 1951. He not only excelled in football, basketball and baseball but also in journalism, vocal music and school play productions. He played a multitude of positions on the football field, and as an accomplished basketball player, Buddy was named to the All-Conference team and helped lead them to the NAIA National Championship in 1954. He continued to enjoy success at his college and pitched professionally in the minor leagues as a member of the Brooklyn Dodger organization in 1956, going back to coach his college alma mater at the varsity and junior varsity levels for two years. Buddy Lord could very well be considered the prototype for well-rounded excellence for St Patrick's-Archbishop Bergan High School student.

# Joe Vojtech Coach 1972-1995

Joe Vojtech's career spanned nearly 23 years and included the roles of Teacher, Coach, Athletic Director, and Principal. While also coaching wrestling and track, Joe's most notable success came as Head Football Coach, a position he held for 17 seasons. More important than wins and losses, his approach was centered on building long-term relationships and this was truly at the heart of his teaching and coaching philosophy. Joe married his high school sweetheart and their two daughters are Bergan Alumni.

# News from the Advancement Office



Remember the days of sitting in your back to school assemblies in the dead heat of August, the sweat rolling down your face and you are thinking, "if only I could feel a breeze of cool air..."

Recently, a group of Bergan Boosters came together and

re-energized the High School Gymnasium Air Conditioning project (including associated learning spaces). In the short time of their re-convening, they have successfully secured a \$10,000 grant for the project from the Fremont Area Community Foundation, in addition to an anonymous contribution of \$10,000. This project is designed to provide an enhanced student-learning environment, modernized athletic facility for student athletes and a climate controlled venue for spectators. Additionally, a climate control system will allow this space to be used for more school and community functions year round.

This climate control system will include adding air conditioning units while also installing the necessary air handlers to provide for year round fresh air management. The air conditioning units will cool the air in the warm months and the air handler units will continuously control the climate in the cold months. The facility

improvements will greatly enhance the numerous student activities, important social events, and athletic events, as they will be held in a more comfortable setting.

It is not only for the benefits of the sport teams that practice and compete in Bergan's gym, it actually has an effect on the estimated 12,439 students, parents, spectators, and other organizations that use Bergan's gym throughout the year. Other facility amenities that would benefit from the improved climate are the weight lifting/fitness room, wrestling room, rehab treatment room, athletic locker rooms (4), and the performing arts stage. All the axillary spaces are very active and used on a regular basis.

The equipment proposed would be the most modern, energy efficient units available, and installed by local contractors. By addressing the air conditioning/ventilation issues for the entire complex, the facility will be more functional because of the improved climate control for the entire year. During winter months, large group gatherings in the gym and extended rooms get very humid causing moisture problems with the floors and walls. The improved ventilation would alleviate those concerns and save money on repair costs. Air conditioning also addresses school safety. The doors currently are being propped open to allow for air circulation on

warmer days and now they will remain closed and locked.

The most obvious advantage would be the improved cooler indoor temperature during the months of April through September. All activities would be held in a comfortable environment. The other advantage will be the improved airflow/ventilation for the months of October through March. The Knight Event dinner and auction fundraiser held in late November, annually hosts over 500 attendees and volunteers in the "converted" gymnasium. Because of the extensive transformation through decorations, and the volume of people, the gym becomes stagnant with a lack of air movement. The air handlers would improve the ventilation and would create a more comfortable event.

As previously mentioned the Boosters working on this project have already secured \$20,000. They are working to generate funds from other vested organizations that support Archbishop Bergan Catholic School and St. Patrick's Catholic Church. 
