Our first completion was at UNO in October. Students attending were:



UNL Math Day is the biggest competition every year with about 1,500 math students from around the state. This year it was Nov 16 and the same eight students attended. All of our Math Bowl matches were decided by 1 question. Lost the first match 2-1, then won the first round of losers bracket 3-2, then were eliminated in the next match 3-2. To get an idea how hard the quiz bowl questions were, those scores are out of 12 questions - most of the questions go unanswered. Before the quiz bowl each student, took the PROBE test - 25 questions designed to be Problems Requiring Original and Brilliant Effort.

In February six Math Club students were at Wayne State College for an Engineering competition. They built a sturdy tower that finished first in the state and 8<sup>th</sup> nationally in their division.



In April the Math Club students competed at the Merten Hasse Mathematics Competition at the University of South Dakota - seven in the pre-calculus division and one in the Algebra II division.
