The class of 2011 ranked first all-time at Archbishop Bergan Catholic School in accepted scholarships per class member at an average of \$26,169. To date, a total of \$601,900 in scholarships have been accepted. Academic Scholarships make up \$236,700 and Athletic Scholarships equal \$365,200. Thirty-nine percent of the students plan to attend a 4 year public college, forty-eight percent plan to attend a 4 year private college, nine percent plan on attending a 2 year community college, leaving four percent who are planning to join the military service prior to college. "Most impressively," Ron Beacom, principal, said, "the Class of 2011 seemed to accomplish all of this without ever taking themselves too seriously, and understanding that they are mere instruments for God to do His work."
