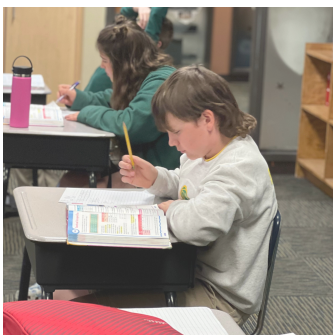


2nd Annual Readathon 2022

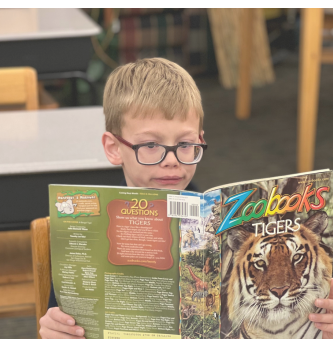


We are excited to announce Archbishop Bergan Catholic School will be participating in our 2nd annual Readathon this year for the Fremont Area Big Give. Last year during the Big Give, we were able to raise over \$43,000! Our goal this year is to have each student in our school family read **4.5 hours** within the Readathon challenge time.



We are asking all families, Preschool through 12th grade, to contact friends and family to sponsor our Readathon by pledging an amount for our event. We recommend flat donations for the event as they are easier to track and collect.
