- 1. Meeting was called to order at 6:30 by Tad Dinkins
- 2. Opening Prayer- Tad Dinkins
- 3. Roll Call:

#### 5. Reports:

- a. Lori McIntyre and Michael Vanek
  - i. Lori presented the Circle of Grace curriculum that is taught at the elementary levels.
  - ii. It was suggested that this information be presented to parents before the start of the school year, either by a parent meeting or a video presentation made by Lori and offered on Sycamore.
  - iii. Michael outlined how the Circle of Grace is taught at each level in the middle/high school.
