The primary goal of the House System is to **nurture caring relationships** among students and encourage a **sense of family** through faith, knowledge, and service. It enables all students to embrace their **potential for leadership** while preparing them to make **positive changes** in the community.

Students are arranged into different mixed grade level groups or houses, each named for a saint that the students would like to emulate. Students meet in their houses weekly for various activities, and houses sit together at weekly mass. Houses participate in **faith sharing activities**, mild competitions, service projects, and school activities that earn points for their houses. At the end of the year, the house that accrues the most points is crowned the house champion.

The benefits of being involved in the House System are outstanding. The faculty have , noticed the younger **students interacting** with older students in ways that never would have happened. Faculty and **student relationships** also improved as a result of interactions outside of the classroom.




Grow IN A CULTURE OF SUCCESS
