### C-L Patriot's Covid Protocols for **CLARKSON SITE**

These practices will be for the fall sport of Volleyball, in Clarkson host sites. It includes JH, Reserve and Varsity competitions. Our goal is to keep the players and fans safe but also still be able to offer a memorable experience for the kids and families.

***We ask that all visiting teams would take it upon themselves to self-screen and temp check team members before they leave. If they are 100.4 or over please have them stay home.***

**-Masks-** Are not mandatory but recommended for fans. We do ask that bench officials wear a mask. Players, Coaches, Refs, & managers are not required to wear a mask.

**Gate-** We will have a table for taking gate, we ask that you use exact change. We will not take gate for lower level competitions. Individuals must show their Covid Pass, which will allow them to pay and enter the facility or use their EHC pass.

**Passes-**Each visiting school will receive **2 passes per player, coach & managers**. It is the player's choice who will get to enter the game but it will be limited to 2 passes. Admin will identify themselves for entry. We ask that you limit the number of attending administrators. **It is the responsibility of the visiting AD/ADMIN to issue their passes to their teams.**

**-Switching benches-** We will not switch benches or sides of the court during the match.

**-Concession-** We will not have a concession stand. Fans are welcome to bring bottled water or packaged snacks. **NO CROCK POTS, COOLERS, ROASTERS FOR REGULAR GAMES.** Tournament games may vary.

**-Book/Stats & Bus Driver-** Each get a Covid pass and will be admitted for free

**C-L Patriot Covid Protocols for LEIGH SITES- Softball and Football**

We encourage those planning to attend sporting events as spectators to self-screen before departing from home. If you feel ill, stay at home.

**Masks-** Although optional, we encourage the use of masks for our fans. While these are open air facilities, we ask people to be mindful of social distancing during softball and football games.

Any students from Leigh or Clarkson sitting in the student section in front of the Crow's Nest for football games must wear a mask.

**Gate-** Payment in exact change is appreciated. Admission is \$5/adults and \$4/students.  
Gate workers are required to wear masks.

**Following the Game-** Parents and spectators are asked to stay off the football field

**Concessions-** We plan to offer our usual concessions which includes popcorn at football and softball and hot dogs at softball. Specific workers will be assigned to the popcorn, hot dogs, and handling of money. Hand sanitizer will be available for patrons.

The Clarkson-Leigh Booster Club will be serving hamburgers.

**Bleachers-** We ask that spectators adhere to social distancing protocols in the bleachers. Reminders will be placed throughout the bleachers.

For softball, the third base line is considered the home (Highway 91) side for spectators while the first base side is for visiting fans.

Currently, our school is operating in the Green Tier. The protocols listed above are subject to change if our school is placed in a different tier.
